- 1. Stewart J. Eisenberg shall abide by the New Jersey Rules of Court, including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:20-1 and R. 1:28-2.
- 2. Mr. Eisenberg shall and hereby does consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as his agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against him that may rise out of his individual participation in this matter.

- 3. Mr. Eisenberg shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction.
- 4. Mr. Eisenberg shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein.
  - 5. Mr. Eisenberg cannot be designated as trial counsel.
  - 6. No proceedings in this matter will be adjourned if Mr. Eisenberg is unavailable.
- 7. Mr. Eisenberg must, within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Order, pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2 and submit an affidavit of compliance.
- 8. Mr. Eisenberg must comply with Rules R. 1:20-1(b), R. 1:28-2 and 1:28B-1(e) on an annual basis and shall submit affidavits of compliance within thirty (30) days of such compliance.
- 9. Pro Hac Vice admission will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payments required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2. Permission to seek pro hac vice shall be automatically terminated for failure to make any required annual payment, upon appropriate notification from the Administrative Office of the Courts that the annual payment has not been made. Proof of such payment, after filing proof of the initial payment, shall be made no later than February 1 of each year, or within thirty (30) days of timely payment of the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2, whichever is later.
- 10. Non-compliance with any of the terms of this Order shall constitute grounds for removal.
- 11. A copy of this Order shall be served on all parties within seven (7) days of the date thereof.
