CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER No. 33

THIS MATTER having been opened by the court for implementing a new method and procedure for the service of Plaintiff Fact Sheets ("PFSs") and implementing a mechanism for service of Defense Fact Sheets ("DFSs"), and the court having held discussions with counsel during status conferences conducted on May 12, 2010 and May 27, 2010 and a case management conference conducted on June 9, 2010, and the court considering various methods and procedures for the service of PFSs and DFSs in the future, and the court simultaneously desiring to have cases selected for trials while the court contemplates the new method for service of PFSs and DFSs and good cause having been shown;

IT IS on this 17th day of June, 2010,

ORDERED as follows:

1. PFSs for Group 11 are due no later than **June 25, 2010**.
2. PFSs for Group 12 from plaintiffs other than those represented by the law firm of Weitz & Luxenberg, are due no later than **August 27, 2010**.
3. On behalf of their plaintiffs, the law firm of Weitz & Luxenberg shall serve an additional 150 PFSs no later than **September 15, 2010**.
4. On behalf of their plaintiffs, the law firm of Laminack, Pirtle & Martines shall serve the following: 50 PFSs on or before July 1, 2010; an additional 100 PFSs on or before August 13, 2010; and an additional 150 PFSs on or before **September 15, 2010**.
5. On behalf of their plaintiffs, the law firm of Douglas & London shall serve the following: 60 PFSs on or before **September 15, 2010**; an additional 34 PFSs on or before **October 15, 2010**; and an additional 33 PFSs no later than **November 15, 2010**.

6. All law firms representing plaintiffs may serve additional PFSs prior to the due dates set forth by the court.
7. A copy of this order shall be posted for counsel within seven (7) days.
