FAILURE TO PROVIDE OUTSTANDING
AUTHORIZATIONS AND/OR MISSING
INFORMATION PURSUANT TO CASE
MANAGEMENT ORDER NOS. 4 AND 19
AND THE AUGUST 14, 2009 ORDER OF
THE COURT**

THIS MATTER having been brought before the Court by McCarter & English, LLP, attorneys for Defendants AstraZeneca Pharmaceuticals LP, AstraZeneca LP, Zeneca Inc., KBI Sub Inc., and Astra USA, Inc. (collectively "AstraZeneca") to dismiss plaintiffs' Complaint with prejudice for failure to provide outstanding authorizations and/or missing information pursuant to Case Management Orders 4 ("CMO 4") and 19 ("CMO 19") and the August 14, 2009 Order of the Court, such dismissal with prejudice

being authorized by the Court, the Court having considered the papers submitted, and for good cause shown;

IT IS on this 20th day of November, 2009;

ORDERED that AstraZeneca's motion is hereby **GRANTED** and that plaintiffs' Complaint be and hereby is dismissed with prejudice as to all parties -- served and unserved -- pursuant to CMO 4, § II(D), and CMO 19, § 3 and the August 14, 2009 Order of the Court; and it is further
