IT IS ON THIS 23rd day of August, 2013;



(f/k/a Ortho-McNeil-Janssen Pharmaceuticals, Inc. f/k/a Janssen Pharmaceutica Inc.) and Johnson & Johnson, who were erroneously designated in the Complaint as Janssen Pharmaceutica, Inc., Janssen Pharmaceutica, L.P., and Johnson & Johnson Company; and it is further

ORDERED that Defendants may move for an Order of Dismissal with prejudice on or around October 22, 2013; and it is further
