ORDERED that Defendants' Motion for an Order requiring release of ~~all~~ DYFS records involving Plaintiff to the Court for in camera review is **GRANTED**; and it is further

ORDERED that DYFS shall release ~~all records relating to Plaintiff~~ *the aforementioned records* to this Court for in camera review and determination regarding release to counsel within 10 days of the date of this Order; and it is further


ORDERED that, upon completing an in camera review of the DYFS records, this Court shall determine in what manner the documents shall be released to Defendants; and it is further

ORDERED that information contained within the released documents shall be used only in the pending civil matter and shall not be used in any other matter in the absence of further Order of the Court, upon proper notice in the Office of the Attorney General and to the Division of Youth and Family Services; and it is further

ORDERED that information contained in or derived from said records shall be protected as confidential pursuant to the terms of the Stipulated Protective Order of Confidentiality already existing in this case, entered by the Honorable Bryan D. Garruto, J.S.C., on August 6, 2007; and it is further

ORDERED that the use of information contained or derived from said records for any purpose other than as set forth above, shall be a violation of this Order and subject to the contempt powers of this Court.
