CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 29

ORDER PERMITTING FILING UNDER SEAL OF BRIEFS AND SUPPORTING PAPERS IN CONNECTION WITH KEMP BRIEFING REGARDING GENERIC EXPERTS

This matter, having been opened to the Court by counsel for the Bayer defendants, the parties having had an opportunity to be heard, and for good cause shown and into order to maintain the coordinated hearing of the *Daubert/Kemp/Brady* motions and the briefing schedule therefore;


IT IS, on this 15 day of September, 2011, hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

(1) Given the expedited *Kemp* schedule, the parties be and hereby are given permission to file under seal the briefs and supporting papers in connection with the *Kemp* briefing regarding generic experts to the extent required by Case Management Order No. 5.

This is a provisional Order and not based on a review of the merits of whether any individual document may qualify for filing under seal. The Order shall expire on a date to be agreed upon by the parties after the merits of the request for maintaining the filing under seal are fully briefed and argued.

(2) The parties shall meet and confer regarding an appropriate schedule for the briefing and hearings regarding the propriety of a continuing seal over submissions in connection with the *Kemp* briefing regarding generic experts.
