USE CONSENT ORDER**

AND NOW, this 3rd day of December 2021, upon consent of all counsel of record in this matter; it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

1. The case of Cheryl Collier (MID-L-004129-21) shall be dismissed without prejudice if plaintiff fails to provide proof of product usage and a materially complete and certified Plaintiff Fact Sheet within 45 days of the date of this Order.
2. Within 45 days of this Order, plaintiff's counsel shall identify whether proof of product usage and a materially complete and certified Plaintiff Fact Sheet has been served pursuant to this Order.
3. Following the 45th day, Defense counsel may submit an Order for dismissal of this case without prejudice if plaintiff has failed to comply with this Order and not identified by plaintiff's counsel as compliant.

ORDERED that service of this Order shall be deemed effectuated upon all parties upon its upload to e-Courts. Pursuant to Rule 1:5-1(a), movant shall serve a copy of this Order on all parties not served electronically within seven (7) days of the date of this Order.
