## I. SCOPE OF ORDER

This Case Management Order ("CMO") amends paragraphs II D of the Case Management Order: Plaintiff Fact Sheets ("CMO: PFS") dated June 12, 2019 as set forth below.

## II. PLAINTIFF FACT SHEETS (PFS)

## **Failure to Serve PFS**

If a plaintiff fails to produce a verified PFS by the Court-ordered deadline, or if a plaintiff serves an egregiously deficient PFS evincing that they have not attempted to comply in good faith with their discovery obligations, counsel for Merck shall notify Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel, and counsel for that plaintiff, in writing of the failure to produce the PFS within the deadline. The notice letter will state that the failure to produce a PFS within fourteen (14) days of the date of the notice letter will result in Merck filing a Motion to Dismiss (MTD) plaintiff's case without prejudice. Plaintiff shall have 14 days to oppose the MTD without prejudice and/or provide a fully responsive and certified PFS. The MTD without prejudice shall be returnable at the next Case Management Conference following the opposition deadline or as otherwise set by the Court.

If the case is dismissed without prejudice pursuant to this Order and is not reinstated within sixty (60) days of that Order, any motion to dismiss with prejudice filed shall be in accordance with R. 4:23-5(a)(2) and shall comply with the notice requirements and procedures set forth in Case Management Order No. 19 ("CMO 19") *and*, in the case of omnibus motions, Order dated July 27, 2021 permitting and explaining the filing of omnibus motions. Counsel for both the Plaintiff and Defendant shall advise whether oral argument is requested or waived.
