

## NOTICE TO THE BAR

### APPLICATION FOR MASS TORT DESIGNATION AND CENTRALIZED MANAGEMENT OF DIGITEK<sup>®</sup> LITIGATION

A previous notice requested comments on the application made for centralized management, but not mass tort designation, of all New Jersey state-court litigation involving the drug Digitek<sup>®</sup> and assignment of that litigation to Bergen County. In response to that Notice, and pursuant to Rule 4:38A and the Mass Torts Guidelines (Administrative Directive #10-07), a second application regarding the Digitek<sup>®</sup> litigation has been submitted by counsel for certain plaintiffs in the litigation, with this second submission an application for mass tort designation and centralized management of that litigation in Atlantic County.

Anyone wishing to comment on or object to this second application regarding the Digitek<sup>®</sup> state-court litigation should provide such comments or objections in writing, with relevant supporting documentation, to Glenn A. After that date the Supreme Court will consider and act on both applications regarding Digitek<sup>®</sup> and any comments received.
