HEARING (SEPTEMBER 30) ON RULE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY SUPREME COURT COMMITTEES ON REFERRAL FROM THE COURT ON OPINION 39 OF THE COMMITTEE ON ATTORNEY ADVERTISING
