NOTICE TO THE BAR

PRIVATE SECTOR CONSTRUCTION LIEN ACTIONS – WHERE TO BE FILED

Pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 2A:44-137, actions involving <u>public</u> sector construction liens are equitable in nature and must be filed in the General Equity Part of the Chancery Division. <u>Private</u> sector construction liens, which seek to fix damages, have been filed both in the General Equity Part of the Chancery Division and in the Civil Part of the Law Division. Because the relief sought in <u>private</u> sector construction lien actions is monetary, however, rather than equitable in nature, both the Conference of General Equity Presiding Judges and the Conference of Civil Presiding Judges have recommended that all such actions be filed solely in the Civil Part of the Law Division.

Accordingly, this Notice is to advise the bar that effective **January 18, 2011**, all actions involving <u>private</u> sector construction liens shall be filed solely in the Civil Part of the Law Division. <u>Public</u> sector construction lien actions shall continue to be filed in the General Equity Part of the Chancery Division.
