Billing notices will be mailed in mid-March. Email reminders only will be sent to online participants. The deadline for response to the billing is April 29, 2011. The Online Registration and Payment Center will be open in February for payment of the 2011 assessment by individual attorneys who have **previously** registered online. Attorneys who have yet to use the online site or who wish to be a part of their firm's group payment should wait for the paper bill (a unique user id and temporary password will be printed on the paper bill).
