SUPREME COURT OF NEW JERSEY

The effects of Hurricane Irene on the State of New Jersey, including the subsequent flooding throughout the State, having resulted in the August 29, 2011 closure of a number of vicinages and having placed severe limitations on local and statewide transportation including the continued suspension of mass transit;

It is ORDERED that in the computation of time periods under the Rules of Court and any statute of limitations, for purposes of filing deadlines August 29, 2011 shall be deemed the same as a legal holiday, with the time period and statutes of limitations tolled for state court matters; and

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the provisions of this Order shall apply to matters in the Supreme Court, the Appellate Division, the Superior Court, and the Tax Court.
