

NOTICE TO THE BAR

REINSTATEMENT FEE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE INELIGIBILITY BASED ON FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE MANDATORY CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENT

Pursuant to Rule 1:42-2(b)(7), the Board on Continuing Legal Education (“Board”) recently recommended to the Supreme Court a reduction in the fee assessed against attorneys who seek reinstatement to active good standing status after being declared administratively ineligible to practice law in New Jersey for failure to comply with the mandatory continuing legal education requirement. The Court on January 7, 2014 approved the Board’s recommendation. Accordingly, for administrative ineligibility that will begin in the 2014 compliance reporting year, the reinstatement fee will be \$100.
