


SUPREME COURT OF NEW JERSEY

It is ORDERED that, pursuant to N.J. Const. Art. VI, sec. 2 par. 3, effective immediately and until further order, the Rules Governing the Courts of the State of New Jersey are supplemented and relaxed in support of the centralized printing and mailing of Special Civil Part regular and certified mail service of process, as follows:

Rule 6:2-1 is supplemented and relaxed so as to authorize the Administrative Director of the Courts, with the approval of the Chief Justice, to approve the form of the Special Civil Part summons; and

Rule 4:4-7 is supplemented and relaxed such that where service of process in Special Civil Part matters is made by registered or certified mail and simultaneously by regular mail, either the return receipt card, the printout of the electronic return receipt provided by the United States Postal Service, or the unclaimed registered or certified mail shall be filed proof of service.
