
AMENDMENTS TO RULES APPENDICES XI-I, XI-J, AND XI-L – NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR WAGE EXECUTION, WAGE EXECUTION, INFORMATION SUBPOENA

In its July 22, 2014 Omnibus Rule Amendment Order the Supreme Court approved changes to three Appendices to the Rules of Court that are used in Special Civil Part cases, with those changes to be effective September 1, 2014. That July 22, 2014 order was previously published and posted as a notice to the bar. The changes are as follows:

1. Appendix XI-I (“Notice of Application for Wage Execution”). The Notice portion of this form has been modified so as to add a line for the benefit of the parties and employers to indicate that only one execution against the judgment debtor’s wages shall be satisfied at a time. This additional language is in accord with N.J.S.A. 2A:17-52 which precludes more than one wage garnishment on one salary at a time.
2. Appendix XI-J (“Wage Execution”). The form of the wage execution has been modified so as to include two additional lines that similarly indicate that only one execution against the judgment debtor’s wages shall be satisfied at a time. This additional language is in accord with N.J.S.A. 2A:17-52, which precludes more than one wage garnishment on one salary at a time. Since the wage execution is generated by the Office of the Special Civil Part Clerk upon request, this amendment does not require any modification of template forms by attorneys who represent judgment-creditors in Special Civil Part cases.

3. Appendix XI-L ("Information Subpoena"). An additional question was added to individual and business entity form of interrogatories to capture asset information for any ownership interest the judgment debtor may have in limited liability companies. Accordingly, this amends question #16 (for individuals) and adds question #6 (for business entities).
