SUPREME COURT OF NEW JERSEY

It is ORDERED that, effective immediately and until further order, the provisions of the Court's September 13, 2010 Order assigning all pending and future state court litigation seeking damages or other relief arising out of alleged injuries from the use of pelvic mesh products manufactured by Ethicon Women's Health and Urology, Gynecare and/or Johnson & Johnson (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "J&J Litigation") and assigning all pending and future state court litigation seeking damages or other relief arising out of alleged injuries from the use of pelvic mesh products manufactured by C.R. Bard, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Bard Litigation") for centralized management (now multicounty litigation) to Atlantic County, as previously amended by the Court's October 31, 2014 Order transferring the J&J Litigation and the Bard Litigation to the Bergen Vicinage for case management by Superior Court Judge Brian R. Martinotti, are hereby further amended so as to reassign all such matters to Superior Court Judge Rachelle L. Harz in the Bergen Vicinage, with all specific references in those prior orders to Judge Martinotti to be read as references to Judge Harz.
