

## **NOTICE TO THE BAR**

### **STATE TAX APPEALS -- ATTORNEYS REQUIRED TO FILE ALL DOCUMENTS IN ECOURTS**

Effective immediately, attorneys are required to electronically file all state tax case documents, including complaints and case initiating motions, via the eCourts electronic filing system (eCourts Tax). Fees will be charged at the time of filing and the Tax Court Management Office will notify the filer of any required additional fees.

Attorneys who file state tax case documents using a method other than eCourts Tax will receive a notice instructing them to file the document through eCourts Tax within 10 days in order to preserve the original received date as the filed date.
