N.J.S.A. 2C:11-5	<b>Reckless Vehicular Homicide (Reckless <u>With</u> Driving While Intoxicated or Refusal to Submit to a</b>
	Breathalyzer Test) and Reckless Vehicular Homicide
	(Reckless <u>Without</u> Driving While Intoxicated or
	Refusal to Submit to a Breathalyzer Test) (4/20/20)
	These two charges were revised pursuant to a statutory
	amendment, effective $1/16/18$ , that proof that the
	defendant failed to maintain a lane in violation of
	N.J.S.A. 39:4–88 may give rise to an inference that the
	defendant was driving recklessly. Reckless Vehicular
	Homicide is a crime of the third degree if the defendant
	proves by a preponderance of the evidence that the
	defendant did not commit any conduct constituting
	driving a vehicle or vessel recklessly other than failing to

	maintain a lane in violation of N.J.S.A. 39:4–88.
N.J.S.A. 2C:14-9(a)	<b>Invasion of Privacy (Observing) (10/21/19)</b> This is a new model charge.
N.J.S.A. 2C:33-3(e)	<b>False Public Alarms – Misuse of 9-1-1 (10/21/19)</b> This is a new model charge.
N.J.S.A. 2C:33-31(a)(7)	<b>Dog Fighting (Fighting Paraphernalia) (5/18/20)</b> This is a new model charge.
