

## SUPREME COURT OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and the New Jersey Department of Treasury have extended the deadlines for filing federal and state tax returns for tax year 2020 by one month, from April 15, 2021 to Monday, May 17, 2021; and

WHEREAS, with regard to judicial financial reporting pursuant to Rule 1:18B, the Court in adopting the May 15 due date for New Jersey judges to submit their annual judicial financial reporting statement as set forth in Court Rule 1:18B-1(d) (“Date by Which to Submit Report”) set that May 15 due date to be one month after the usual April 15 tax filing deadline;

It is ORDERED, pursuant to N.J. Const., Art. VI, sec. 2, par. 3., that the provisions of Rule 1:18B-1(d) are relaxed and supplemented such that the date by which judges must submit their judicial financial reporting statements for calendar 2020 is extended to June 15, 2021.
