NOTICE TO THE BAR

IMPLEMENTATION OF TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION REQUIREMENT FOR ALL JUDICIARY APPLICATIONS USED BY ATTORNEYS; ADDITIONAL CLE TRAINING OFFERED

Attorneys were previously advised of the added security requirement to use twofactor authentication when accessing the online 2021 Attorney Registration application (Notice dated November 30, 2020). Last month attorneys were further advised that two-factor authentication would be expanding to all Judiciary applications used by attorneys (Notice dated April 5, 2021 as modified by Notice dated April 28, 2021). This notice is to advise that the expansion of two-factor authentication to all Judiciary applications used by attorneys will be effective May 16, 2021.

As indicated in those earlier notices, two-factor authentication uses the email address or cell phone number previously provided by attorneys and verified/updated as part of the 2021 Attorney Registration process. To assist attorneys through this expansion of the two-factor authentication beyond the Attorney Registration application, the Superior Court Clerk's Office is making available at no cost training on the use of the two-factor authentication process. The April 28, 2021 <u>Notice</u> set forth a listing of the on-line training sessions being made available through the end of May.

The sessions are conducted using Microsoft Teams. Attorneys must register in advance. Additional training sessions have been scheduled for June, as follows:
