Middlesex County Vicinage to Conduct Primary Election Day Hearings

Early voting will once again be available to New Jersey voters. Recently, a new law (P.L. 2021, c.40) was signed permitting in-person early voting in New Jersey **for primary and general elections only**. This new option enables all registered voters to cast their ballot in-person, using a voting machine, during a nine-day period prior to Election Day to the General Election and three-day period prior to the Primary Election at any of the early voting locations within Middlesex County.

In-person early voting locations will be open **Friday**, **June 3 through Sunday**, **June 5 for the 2022 Primary Election**. Hours will be **Friday and Saturday**, **10 am – 8 pm and Sunday**, **10 am – 6 pm**. No appointment is necessary. No matter where you live in Middlesex County, you can vote your specific ballot at any of your county's designated in-person early voting locations. This allows voters to choose to vote, in person, when it's most convenient to their schedules. No appointment is necessary.

Registered voters will be able to cast their ballot, in person, using a voting machine, during the 3-day period prior to Primary Election Day from Friday, June 3, 2022, to Sunday June 5, 2022 (the "Early Voting Period"). Voting hours will be Friday-Saturday, 10:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. and Sunday 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. "In-person" Early Voting Locations in the following municipalities in Middlesex County are: Woodbridge, Edison, Monroe, Old Bridge, Perth Amboy, Piscataway, New Brunswick, Sayreville, South Brunswick and East Brunswick. Voting in-person will take place at a voter's designated polling place from 6:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. on Primary Election Day, June 7, 2022. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

Superior Court judges will be available in the Middlesex Vicinage to conduct remote hearings for any election challenges or issues in Middlesex County, as follows:

- o For the Early Voting Period, Friday, June 3, 2022, to Saturday, June 4, 2022, from 10:00am to 8:00pm and Sunday, June 5, 2022, from 10:00am-6:00pm; and
- On Tuesday, June 7, 2022, from 6:00 AM to the close of the polls at 8:00 PM.

Anyone seeking to petition the court on a voting or election issue **during the Early Voting weekend** (June 3 through June 5) can contact the County Clerk's Office-Elections Division or the Board of Elections Office at the numbers set forth below to arrange for an appearance before the designated judge by telephone.

Anyone seeking to petition the court on a voting or election issue either **during normal court hours or after hours on Tuesday** (June 7), can contact the County Clerk's Office-Elections Division or the Board of Elections Office at the numbers set forth below to arrange for an appearance before the designated judge by telephone.

If appropriate, the matter will be heard promptly by a designated judge with notice to the election officials. Election officials, petitioners, and attorneys will be able to appear before the designated judge by video or telephone. Voters and residents with questions about the **June 7th** election or who are seeking assistance in casting their vote can contact the Middlesex County Clerk's Office – Elections Division, and/or the Middlesex County Board of Elections.
