2023-2025 SUPREME COURT RULES COMMITTEE REPORTS – PUBLICATION FOR COMMENT

The Supreme Court invites written comments on the 2023-2025 reports of four of its Rules committees for this rules cycle. In those reports, the committees (as listed below) make numerous recommendations to the Supreme Court for rule amendments and other non-rule administrative actions. As noted previously, the Court has staggered the reporting cycles of its standing committees, such that approximately half submit their respective reports each year.

The four committees whose 2023-2025 reports are published with this notice for comment are as follows:

- (1) Criminal Practice Committee**
- (2) Committee on Diversity, Inclusion, and Community Engagement**
- (3) Family Practice Committee**
- (4) Municipal Court Practice Committee**

The Committee on Complementary Dispute Resolution and the Committee on the Rules of Evidence, both of which also are part of this cycle, did not submit reports for 2023-2025.
