## **Judiciary Releases Annual Report**

The New Jersey Judiciary today announced the release of its 2011-2012 Annual Report.

In his introduction, Chief Justice Stuart Rabner notes that "true justice depends not only on the fairness of court rulings but also on a system that is accessible to all." The annual report provides details on a number of projects aimed at expanding access to the courts, including the statewide Access and Fairness Initiative, expanded online access to court services and programs, and more Spanish-language information on the Judiciary website, njcourts.com.
