Justice Anne Patterson to Give Keynote Address at Hudson Vicinage Law Day Awards Ceremony

Supreme Court Associate Justice Anne M. Patterson will give the keynote address at the annual Hudson Vicinage Law Day event on Wednesday, May 1, at noon at the Justice William J. Brennan Jr. Courthouse, 583 Newark Ave., Jersey City.

As part of the Law Day celebration, students from Hudson County submitted artwork, photography, essays, rap songs and poems related to this year's Law Day theme: "Realizing the Dream: Equality for All." The winners of these contests, and the Hudson County Mock Trial competition, are invited to attend the ceremony with their families, classmates, principals, and teachers. Awards will be given for each category.

Assignment Judge Peter F. Bariso Jr. said, "We are delighted to have Justice Patterson join us to celebrate Law Day with our mock trial and contest winners. The Law Day committee was very impressed with the quality of this year's contest entries, and we look forward to showing off some of Hudson County's best students to the justice."
