Burlington Vicinage to Conduct Workshops for the Public

The Burlington Vicinage will hold a series of workshops on court-related topics as part of its community outreach efforts.

The workshops are conducted by the Office of the Ombudsman and civil division staff and are held from 4 to 6 p.m. in the jury assembly room on the ground floor of the Burlington County Courthouse, 49 Rancocas Road, Mount Holly.

The seminar on Evictions vs. Ejectments will provide information to landlords and tenants on the filing process, how to remove tenants from your property and how to remove an unwanted boarder from your property.

The collection of a money judgment seminar will address the process of collecting money judgments in the special civil part and what happens next.

The money judgment seminar will provide information to individuals who have a money judgment filed against them in special civil part and offer options.

Sessions are free and open to the public. They are informational only. Individual cases cannot be discussed or resolved. No reservations are required.
