Essex Vicinage Celebrates Black History Month

In celebration of Black History Month, the Essex Vicinage will hold its annual Spirit Program on Thursday, Feb. 27 from 12:30 to 2 p.m. in the first floor rotunda of the Essex County Historic Courthouse, 470 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Newark.
