The Ocean Vicinage is seeking volunteers to participate in the Vicinage Civil Mediation Program under the direction of the Civil Division staff.

Mediation is a dispute resolution process in which an impartial third party, the mediator, facilitates negotiations among the parties to help them reach a mutually acceptable settlement.

Volunteers trained in accordance with Court Rule 1:40-12 to work with litigants to resolve their disputes by developing a voluntary agreement that is acceptable to all without having to go before a judge.

Volunteers are needed on Mondays and Wednesdays from 9 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the Ocean County Courthouse , 100 Hooper Ave., Toms River.

Free training will be provided.
