Burlington Vicinage to Offer Free Seminar on Juveniles in the Court System

A free workshop on juveniles in the court system will be held on Thursday, June 26 from 4 to 5:30 p.m. in the jury assembly room at the Burlington Courts Facility, 49 Rancocas Rd., Mount Holly.

Speakers for the seminar are court professionals from the family and probation divisions: Diane Donegan, JoAnn Schlindwein and Jack Hvizdos. The panelists will discuss the juvenile justice process including pre- to post-disposition, court procedures for juvenile delinquency matters and court resources and services.

Delinquency is an act by a juvenile which, if committed by an adult, would be a crime or a violation of an ordinance or regulation. Juvenile delinquency cases involve violations by youth under the age of 18.

The seminar is sponsored by the Office of the Ombudsman. This is an informational session only. No individual cases can be discussed or resolved. Pre-registration is not required.
