Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage to Host Naturalization Ceremony

The Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage will host a naturalization ceremony to celebrate Constitution and Citizenship Day on Tuesday, Sept. 16 at 10 a.m. in the ceremonial courtroom of the Gloucester County Old Courthouse, 1 N. Broad St., Woodbury.

Assignment Judge Georgia M. Curio will preside over the event and administer the Oath of Citizenship.

“We are pleased to celebrate the United States Constitution with those who have chosen to become U.S. citizens and to embrace the rights and responsibilities embodied in our most important founding document,” said Judge Curio.

The U.S. Marine Reserves Honor Guard will present the colors. The Woodbury High School choir will sing the national anthem and “God Bless America.” Juliet Njoku, a vicinage senior probation officer and a naturalized citizen who immigrated here from Nigeria, will give the keynote address.

The applicants for citizenship, who live in Cumberland, Gloucester or Salem County, come from 15 countries.

Constitution and Citizenship Day is observed on the anniversary of the signing of the U.S. Constitution on Sept. 17, 1787.
