Atlantic/Cape May Vicinage Celebrates National Adoption Day

The Atlantic/Cape May Vicinage will hold National Adoption Day celebrations on Thursday, Nov. 20 in Cape May County and Friday, Nov. 21 in Atlantic County. This year the vicinage will finalize the adoption of 30 children into their forever homes.

The Cape May County adoption proceedings and celebration will begin at 8:45 a.m. at the Cape May County Courthouse, 9 N. Main St., Cape May Court House. Adoptions will be conducted by Assignment Judge Julio L. Mendez and Judges Nancy Ridgway and John Rauh.

In Atlantic County, adoptions will begin at 9 a.m. in the jury assembly room on the first floor of the Atlantic County Civil Courts Building, 1201 Bacharach Blvd., Atlantic City. The proceedings will be conducted by Judges Mendez, Michael Blee, Octavia Melendez, Damon Tyner and Jeffrey Waldman. Gifts will be presented to the children.

The events in Atlantic and Cape May counties will be co-hosted by the Superior Court Family Division and the New Jersey Division of Child Protection & Permanency, in collaboration with the Court Appointed Special Advocates of Atlantic and Cape May Counties and Surrogates Sue Sheppard of Cape May County and James Curcio of Atlantic County.

National Adoption Day is an annual event in which courts and communities in all 50 states join to finalize thousands of adoptions and to celebrate families who adopt.
