Hudson Vicinage to Participate in the 2015 Mock Trial Competition

The Hudson Vicinage preliminary mock trial competition will begin on Monday, Jan. 26 and will conclude on Friday, Jan. 29. The mock trials, which begin at 4:30 p.m. each day, will be held in the Historic William J. Brennan Court House, 583 Newark Ave., Jersey City.

The competition includes public and private local schools that are pitted against each other. Students play roles such as plaintiff, defendant, attorney, witnesses and jurors in a fictional civil court case designed by the New Jersey State Bar Foundation. The winners of the county competition will be honored at the Law Day ceremony on May 1 in the Brennan Court House.
