Assignment Judge Ernest M. Caposela to Administer Oath of Citizenship at Passaic Vicinage Law Day Celebration

Assignment Judge Ernest M. Caposela will administer the Oath of Citizenship to 30 new citizens during the Passaic Vicinage Law Day celebration on Friday, May 1 from 10 to 11 a.m. in the Freeholders Meeting Room at the Passaic County Administration Building, 401 Grand St., Paterson.

The 2015 Law Day theme is "Magna Carta: Symbol of Freedom Under Law."

Law Day activities began in February with a poem, poster and video contest for middle and high school students. Students who submitted winning entries are invited back to the Law Day program on May 1.

All schools represented in the contest also were invited to participate in the Law Day mock trial. Two finalists, Passaic Valley High School in Little Falls and Eastside High School in Paterson, were invited back on May 1 for the final competition. The winner will be announced during a pizza luncheon, when all students are recognized for their contributions to this year's program.

A panel discussion, "Domestic Violence and the Law," will be held on Monday, May 4 at 7 p.m. at Women in Transition in Wayne. Panelists will include attorneys who specialize in the area of domestic violence.

The Law Day program is sponsored by the Passaic Vicinage Law Day Committee. The committee is a collaboration of Passaic Vicinage, the Passaic County Bar Association, the Passaic Vicinage Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns, and the Passaic County Prosecutor's Office.
