New Jersey Sen. Paul A. Sarlo to Speak at Bergen County Law Day Program

New Jersey State Sen. Paul A. Sarlo will give the keynote address at the Bergen Vicinage's annual Law Day program on Friday, May 1 at 3 p.m. at the Court Street entrance to the Bergen County Justice Center, 10 Main St., Hackensack.

Judge Susan J. Steele, chair of the Bergen Vicinage Law Day Committee, will give welcoming remarks. The Bergen County Sheriff's Department Honor Guard Unit will present the colors and Bergen County Prosecutor John L. Molinelli will lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Acting Assignment Judge Robert P. Contillo will administer the Oath of Citizenship to 25 new citizens. D. Gayle Loftis, of the New Jersey Daughters of the American Revolution Claverack Chapter will present American flags to each of the new citizens. Olivia Wilson, a student of Ridgefield Park High School, will sing "The Star Spangled Banner," and remarks will be given by Bergen County Bar Association President Robert E. Laux.

As in years past, the Ridgefield Park High School Chorus, under the direction of Paul Simeone, will provide music for the celebration.

The Bergen County "My County" Poster Contest awards will be presented by Bergen County Clerk John S. Hogan. Mock trial competition awards will be presented by Laux to Bergen Catholic High School.

Parking will be available at 150 River St. in Hackensack. Shuttle buses are available to and from the justice center.

Established by President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1958, Law Day was designated as "a day of national dedication to the principles of government under law." This year's Law Day theme is "Magna Carta: Symbol of Freedom Under Law."
