Burlington Vicinage to Hold Seminar on Teen Dating Safety

As a part of its Law Day celebration, the Burlington Vicinage Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns will hold a "Date Safe" seminar on Wednesday, May 6 at 6 p.m. in the Fellowship Hall of St. Matthew Lutheran Church, 318 Chester Ave., Moorestown.

Family division staff members Reema Scaramella and Susan Fortino will provide teens and their parents with information about dating violence.

The seminar will address dating violence, will bring awareness to early warning signs of violence, and will provide information about available services.

The Burlington Vicinage Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns is chaired by Judge Paula T. Dow. The membership is composed of judges, court staff, and volunteer residents from Burlington County. Their primary charge is to examine issues of importance to racial/ethnic minorities and to the community at large to achieve fair and equal access to court services and programs.

The seminar is free and open to the public. Registration is not required.
