Appellate Division to Hear Oral Argument in the Monmouth Vicinage

Oral argument in five appellate cases will be heard on Monday, July 27 beginning at 9 a.m. in the Monmouth County Courthouse, 71 Monument Park, Freehold. Appellate Division Judges Michael A. Guadagno and Jack M. Sabatino will hear cases on that date.

This is an excellent opportunity for students, attorneys and the public to observe the appellate process. Appellate arguments are often heard in Hackensack, Morristown, Newark and Trenton as well as other locations. The Appellate Division also schedules arguments at Rutgers School of Law-Newark several times each year to give laws students the opportunity to attend and learn.

The Appellate Division of the Superior Court is the state's intermediate appellate court. Appellate Division judges hear appeals from decisions of the trial courts, the Tax Court and state administrative agencies. The chief justice names appellate division judges from among the judges of the Superior Court. Each of the 32 appellate judges is assigned to one of eight parts. Each case is heard by a two- or three-judge panel formed by members of one part.
