Essex Vicinage to Host Naturalization Ceremony

The Essex Vicinage will host a naturalization ceremony on Wednesday, Sept. 30 at 1:30 p.m. in Courtroom 200 of the Historic Court House, 470 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Newark.

Assignment Judge Sallyanne Floria will preside over the event and administer the Oath of Allegiance to 35 candidates for citizenship. The candidates range in age from 18 to 67 years old and come from 17 countries.

"This is an opportunity for us to reflect on the United States Constitution and the significance of our country's original motto "E pluribus unum," which means 'Out of Many, One.' I am honored to administer the oath of allegiance to those who have chosen to become United States citizens," said Judge Floria.

Scheduled to participate in the program are Essex County Executive Joseph N. DiVincenzo Jr., U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services District Director John E. Thompson, the Essex County Sheriff's Office Honor Guard and vocalist Brittany Boardwick, who will sing the national anthem.
