The festivities will continue the following day at the Liberty Science Center for all families who have finalized adoptions during the year. A total of 51 adoptions will have been finalized in 2015.

The National Adoption Center website remarks, "there are no unwanted children...just unfound families." National Adoption Day is an annual event that seeks to raise public awareness of children in foster care who are waiting to find permanent and loving families. Courts and communities across the country conduct programs to finalize adoptions of children to celebrate the adoptive families.
