Camden Vicinage Welcomes Historical Re-Enactor Daisy Nelson Century in Celebration of Women’s History Month

In celebration of Women’s History Month, Assignment Judge Deborah Silverman Katz has announced that the Camden Vicinage will host a free program featuring Daisy Nelson Century, an historical re-enactor, on Tuesday, March 22 from 11 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. in Courtroom 63 at the Hall of Justice, 101 S. Fifth St., Camden.

Century will portray influential and inspiring women throughout history, including abolitionists Harriet Tubman and Sojourner Truth; pilot Bessie Coleman; entrepreneur and activist Madame C. J. Walker; Mary Fields, the first African-American woman employed as a mail carrier in the U.S.; Phillis Wheatley, the first published African American female poet; and Hatshepsut, the longest reigning female pharaoh of Egypt. Audience members also will have the opportunity to ask questions following the performance.

Century is an actress, speaker, author, radio talk show host and educator. As an historical re-enactor, she has traveled all over the U.S. and performed for such organizations as the Smithsonian Associates in Washington, D.C., the American Institute for History Education in New Jersey, the American Historical Theater in Philadelphia, and the College Park Aviation Museum in Maryland among many others. She also is a middle school science teacher.

“We are honored to welcome Dr. Century. Her performance is sure to educate and inspire us,” said Judge Silverman Katz.

The program is free and open the public.
