## Supreme Court of New Jersey to Hear Oral Arguments in Camden

In celebration of the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Rutgers University, the Supreme Court will hear oral arguments at Rutgers Law School in Camden on Wednesday.

Oral arguments will be heard in two cases on Wednesday, Oct. 26, beginning at 10 a.m. in the Archer & Greiner Moot Courtroom, 217 N. Fifth St., Camden. Following the arguments, the Court will meet with law students and faculty for a question-and-answer session at 1:30 p.m.

"We are delighted to help Rutgers University celebrate this milestone achievement," said Chief Justice Stuart Rabner. "We hope everyone in attendance, particularly law students, will find the arguments a valuable educational experience."

The Supreme Court last heard oral arguments at Rutgers Law School in Camden in March 2009.

The court will hear two cases: NL Industries, Inc. v. State and State v. James P. Kucinski. The first asks the court to consider "Is the State entitled to dismissal of plaintiff's action, which seeks recovery of cleanup damages associated with lead contamination pursuant to the Spill Compensation and Control Act?" The second case asks "Did the prosecutor's cross-examination relating to defendant's silence and lack of detail provided to the police during his post-arrest interrogation violate defendant's right to remain silent and/or deprive him of a fair trial?"
