Press Advisory: Supreme Court Scheduled to Hear Arguments Next Week in North Jersey Media Group v. Township of Lyndhurst

The Supreme Court is scheduled to hear oral arguments in the case of North Jersey Media Group v. Township of Lyndhurst on Wednesday, Nov. 9 at 1 p.m.

The issue before the court is: “Are these law enforcement agencies required to release their records relating to this high-speed police chase and shooting under the Open Public Records Act (OPRA), N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 to- 1, or the common law?”
