## **Middlesex Vicinage Celebrates Adoption Day**

Middlesex Vicinage will celebrate National Adoption Day on Tuesday, Nov. 15 at the Middlesex County Courthouse, 56 Paterson St., New Brunswick.

Adoption proceedings for 17 children and their families will begin at 9 a.m. Presiding Family Division Judge Deborah Venezia will officiate.

Following the proceedings, a ceremony will be held in the courtroom of Assignment Judge Travis L. Francis. Opening remarks will be made by Judge Venezia, State Sen. Joseph Vitale, Department of Children and Families Commissioner Allison Blake and John J. Hoagland Jr. of PSE&G.

National Adoption Day is an annual event in which courts and communities in all 50 states come together to finalize thousands of adoptions and celebrate families who adopt. The event seeks to raise awareness of the need for adoptive homes and to show appreciation for caregivers who choose to adopt.

The vicinage's program is co-hosted by the Division of Child Protection and Permanency (DCP&P), the Middlesex County Board of Chosen Freeholders, the Middlesex County Bar Association and the Middlesex County Surrogate's Office. The vicinage held its first adoption celebration in 2007.

Although adoption proceedings are closed to the public, arrangements will be made for reporters to interview willing families afterward.
