Caposela and Passaic County Surrogate Bernice Toledo. Flowers and certificates will be provided to all adoptive parents, compliments of the Passaic County Surrogate.

The reception will also include games, arts and crafts and face painting. Staff from the Division of Child Protection and Permanency (DCP&P) will dress up as Disney characters and assist with all of the festivities. Each child will also receive a gift provided by DCP&P, the Passaic County Surrogate's Office and Superior Court Judge Justine Niccollai. The Court Appointed Special Advocates of Passaic County, the Office of the Passaic County Clerk and the Passaic County Bar Association are also assisting.

National Adoption Day is an annual event in which courts and communities in all 50 states come together to finalize thousands of adoptions and to celebrate families who choose to adopt. The vicinage established its adoption celebration in 2007.
