Supreme Court to Hear Oral Arguments In Connection with Affordable Housing Issues

Oral arguments in a case that involves issues of fair housing will be heard at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 30 in the Supreme Court courtroom on the 8th floor of the Hughes Justice Complex, 25 Market St., Trenton.

The issue before the court is: *When calculating a municipality's fair share obligation, how should affordable housing needs that accumulated from 1999 through 2015 should be addressed?*

Seating for the media is limited and will be reserved in the order requests are received. Only one seat will be reserved for each news organization. Reporters are asked to be seated by 9:45 a.m. At 9:55 a.m., unused reserved seats will be given to reporters on a waiting list.

News outlets must make arrangements in advance to bring cameras into the courtroom. If necessary, pool cameras for still and video will be designated. Call the Judiciary communications office at 609-292-9580 to reserve a seat and to make camera arrangements.
