Paterson Board of Education President Dr. Christopher Irving will serve as keynote speaker at a Passaic Vicinage program celebrating Black History Month.

The event will be held on Friday, Feb. 24 from 12:30 to 1:45 p.m. in the Freeholder's Meeting Room on the second floor of the Passaic County Administration Building, 401 Grand St., Paterson.

Irving, born and raised in Paterson, is the founder of the Ceceilyn Miller Institute for Leadership and Diversity in America (CMI), a non-profit organization that conducts leadership and diversity training.

The Rosa L. Parks School of Fine and Performing Arts choir will perform at the event and a video narrated by high school student Malcolm London, entitled "High School Training Ground" will be shown. The event is free and open to the public.
