The event will be held Thursday, May 4 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. at the Redshaw Elementary School, 216 Livingston Ave., New Brunswick.

Court representatives and attorneys will conduct free workshops in the following areas:

- Landlord/tenant issues, including an overview of basic landlord and tenant rights and landlord/tenant court.
- Child support, including the basics of filing for child support and modifying or terminating child support agreements.
- Legal issues surrounding immigration issues, such as deportation and the consequences related to criminal and municipal court convictions.
- Domestic violence prevention and available resources for domestic violence victims.
- Criminal Justice Reform and its impact.

The sessions are open to all Middlesex County residents. Court representatives and attorneys will conduct the sessions and will be available to answer general questions from the public. Personal cases will not be discussed or resolved.
