Supreme Court to hear Oral Argument in State v. Amed Ingram

The Supreme Court will hear oral argument in *State v. Amed Ingram* on Tuesday, May 16 at 10 a.m. in the Supreme Court courtroom in the Hughes Justice Complex at 25 Market St., Trenton.

The issue before the Court is, “At a pretrial detention hearing pursuant to New Jersey’s Bail Reform Act, N.J.S.A. 2A:162-15 to -26, may the State establish probable cause by proffer, rather than producing live testimony from a witness with first-hand knowledge of the offense?”

Seating for the media is limited and will be reserved in the order requests are received. Only one seat will be reserved for each news organization.
