Burlington Vicinage to Hold Child Support Termination Law, Criminal Justice Reform Seminars

The Burlington Vicinage will hold seminars on the child support termination law and criminal justice reform on Monday, Oct. 2 at the Burlington County Library, 5 Pioneer Blvd., Westampton.

The child support termination law seminar will be held at 5:30 p.m. The criminal justice reform seminar will follow at 6:30 p.m.

Court staff from the probation division will speak about recent changes in child support termination law that went into effect Feb. 1.

Pretrial Services staff from the Judiciary's criminal division will provide information about changes to the criminal justice system in New Jersey. On Jan. 1, 2017, the state moved from a system that relied principally on setting monetary bail as a condition of release to a risk-based system that is more objective, promotes public safety and is fairer to defendants because it is unrelated to their ability to pay monetary bail.

The seminars are free and open to the public. No registration is required.
