## **Monmouth Vicinage to Hold Drug Court Graduation Ceremony**

The Monmouth Vicinage will conduct its 25<sup>th</sup> drug court graduation ceremony on Monday, November 27<sup>th</sup> at 9:30 a.m. at the Monmouth County Library, 125 Symmes Dr., Manalapan.

At the ceremony, 25 drug court participants will be recognized for advancing through the four phases of drug court and satisfying all of the significant requirements of the drug court program. Former Monmouth Vicinage Assignment Judge Lawrence M. Lawson will be the keynote speaker.

Assignment Judge Lisa P. Thornton said, "We continue to recognize the remarkable achievements and progress of our drug court graduates. We are also thankful for the efforts of our drug court team members and their positive impact on the success of the drug court program."

Superior Court Judge Honora O'Brien Kilgallen, who presides over the vicinage's drug court, said, "It is extraordinary how many of our graduates have reunited with loved ones, furthered their education, obtained promotions in employment, regained driving privileges, and more. The graduates have truly realized the rewards that come with recovery, and we wish them continued success in their recovery efforts."

The number of drug court participants in Monmouth County has grown steadily since the program's inception more than 16 years ago. The vicinage now has 394 active participants and 456 participants have graduated from the program.

The drug court program is a highly specialized team process within the existing Superior Court structure that relies upon a unique, collaborative relationship between criminal justice officials and drug treatment professionals to address non-violent, drug-related cases. Drug court programs are rigorous, requiring completion of four phases during five years of intensive drug and alcohol treatment and testing. Participants follow a tightly structured regimen of treatment and recovery.
