Union Vicinage Celebrates Law Day 2018

The Union Vicinage, in partnership with the Union County Bar Association, will host a variety of Law Day activities on Friday, May 4. This year's Law Day theme is "Separation of Powers: Framework for Freedom."

The celebration will be held from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the Union County Courthouse, 2 Broad St., Elizabeth, in Assignment Judge Karen M. Cassidy's courtroom.

U.S. Magistrate Judge Steven C. Mannion will be the guest speaker.

Local students from several schools in the county will participate. The bar association and the Union Vicinage will acknowledge three winners in each category of the poster, essay and video contests held earlier in the year as part of students' Law Day learning activities.

The Burnet Middle School All Star Select Chorus will provide entertainment.

Law Day is a national event established by President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1958 as "a day of national dedication to the principles of government under law."
